Young economists, such as graduate students or post-docs are encouraged to apply.

Procedures: Conference language is English. Participants should submit extended abstracts or full papers using submission form at <http://wiem-conference.pl>. Submissions must describe: (1) objectives, (2) methodology and (3) results of the research. Considering the still uncertain **COVID-19 pandemic** situation we decided that all conference sessions will be organized as **online live presentations**. Participation in WIEM 2021 conference will involve presenting your research online using video conference software.

Finances: For this edition the conference fee is reduced to 50 EUR (paid upon notification of acceptance).

Prize: The Best Paper Prize for Young Economists in the amount of 500 EUR will be awarded for an outstanding paper. Please check eligibility on the website.
